The level 3 Animal care course is designed to assist the student in understanding the basic needs of animals, from the information provided obtain a better understanding of the animal profile and then be able to identify problems. Students will then be able to comfortably understand animal breeds and at an early stage pass on any problems or information to vets or owners.

Typical tasks include:

- cleaning and grooming the animals
- preparing food and feeding the animals
- checking for illness and signs of distress
- cleaning out animals' accommodation and changing bedding
- keeping relevant records and bookings where applicable
- answering questions and queries from visitors.

Course Duration & Fees

All students have one year to complete this course from date of registration.

On average this course is completed in **140 hours (7/8 months)**.
